I. SIN SEPARATED MAN FROM GOD

1. God commanded man to not eat of the Tree of the Knowledge of Good and Evil. (Genesis 2:16-17)
2. Man chose to disobey God, sin entered the human race. Fellowship with God was broken!(Genesis 3:1-7; Romans 5:12, 3:23; Isaiah 53:6)
3. Through the years, man has tried many ways to “get right with God,” or be “reconciled” to God, but he cannot do this himself.

The long red piece of felt is placed over the black felt square, forming a red cross. This shows how Christ’s death on the cross brought man and God together again.
